Outboard Operation-

Key must always be inserted into kill switch on tiller handle in order for engine to start. The leash should be tethered to the drivers wrist or clothing during operation. Turn throttle on tiller arm to START position. Make sure motor is in the neutral position. The engine will not start in forward or reverse. Pull out choke and pull cord to start engine. When motor starts, push in choke and idle engine down. Make sure motor is completely idled down(turn away from start) before switching to forward or reverse. Check the surroundings before maneuvering boat. To stop the engine, pull the clip (key) from the stop switch or push in the stop switch.

DO NOT RUN ENGINE IN SHALLOW WATER. Lift engine in shallow water. To Tilt, move the lever to the tilt position, then raise the outboard motor until the tilt mechanism engages. To return the outboard motor to the normal running position, move the tilt lever to the RUN position, raise the outboard motor slightly to disengage the tilt mechanism, then slowly lower the engine.
